Lesson Generalization: When **c** and **g** have a soft sound, they will be followed by the letters **i, e, or y**. Suffixes that follow the soft **c** or **g** will always begin with an **i** or an **e**: **ian, ion, ious, ence**. When the letters **c** and **g** have a hard sound, they will be followed by **a, o, or u**.
